

## SWRRG SERVICES LIST

### Waste Assessment:

- ⇒ Includes initial questionnaire, filled out by business/school/institution
  - ⇒ Walk through of facility with photos
  - ⇒ Interviews of crucial personnel
  - ⇒ Investigation of what materials are generated, where, where it ends up and how
- COST: \$500 PLUS TRAVEL, FOR STANDARD ASSESSMENT, UP TO 12 HOURS OF WORK**

### Participatory Waste Audit (recommended):

- ⇒ Includes Waste Assessment Services (above)
  - ⇒ Select locations (rooms, individual schools or facilities) and days (either in the same week or over a set of weeks, to be most representative)
  - ⇒ SWRRG creates system for temporary bin system, trains participants on bin use and avoiding contamination
  - ⇒ Employees or students serve as monitors for separation into bins
  - ⇒ Weighing can be done by SWRRG (if daily waste audit visit is timed for the end of the day) or by the participants, or a combination of both
  - ⇒ Report by SWRRG with recommendations on materials which could be recycled and estimate of potential savings, additional participants needed, bins and configuration thereof, potential haulers and recycling destinations
  - ⇒ Recommendations on future data collection by the audited facility and using their recycling improvements for positive publicity
- COST: \$650 FOR UP TO BASIC 15 HOURS OF WORK; PLUS TRAVEL AND \$100 PER DAY OF AUDIT**

### Non-Participatory Waste Audit

- ⇒ Includes Waste Assessment Services (above)
  - ⇒ Select locations (rooms, individual schools or facilities) and days (either in the same week or over a set of weeks, to be most representative)
  - ⇒ SWRRG sets up temporary bin system
  - ⇒ SWRRG employees serve as monitors for separation into bins
  - ⇒ Weighing can be done by SWRRG or by participants, or combination of both
  - ⇒ Report by SWRRG with recommendations on materials which could be recycled and estimate of potential savings, additional participants needed, bins and configuration thereof, potential haulers and recycling destinations
  - ⇒ Recommendations on future data collection by the audited facility and using their recycling improvements for positive publicity
- COST: \$650 FOR UP TO BASIC 15 HOURS OF WORK; PLUS TRAVEL AND \$250 PER DAY OF AUDIT—TWO AUDITORS FOR FULL DAYS.**
